INVITATION TO BID FOR
Construction of Barangay Malibago Health Station

The Municipality of Saint Bernard, through the Department of Health Center for Health Development-Eastern Visayas intends to apply the sum of **One Million One Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP1,100,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Construction of Barangay Malibago Health Station**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Bidders should have completed, within ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Municipality of Saint Bernard and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00AM – 5:00PM, Monday-Friday, except holidays. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents equivalent to 1% of the Approved Budget for Contract (A.B.C.) or Eleven Thousand Pesos (PhP 11,000.00).

The Municipality of Saint Bernard will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on November 4, 2010 at the Conference Room of LGU-Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte, which shall be open to all interested parties. Bids must be delivered to the address below **on or before November 16, 2010** to the Bids and Awards Committee, LGU-Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte 6616. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the stated address. Late bids shall not be accepted. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms:

FORM OF BID SECURITY	MINIMUM AMOUNT
a. Cash, certified check, cashier's check/ manager's check, bank draft, or;	1% of the ABC
b. Irrevocable letter of credit issued by a reputable commercial bank	1% of the ABC
c. Bank guarantee confirmed by a reputable local bank; or	1.5% of the ABC
d. Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a reputable surety or insurance company; or	2.5% of the ABC
e. Any combination of the foregoing forms	The total amount shall not be less than 2.5% of the ABC

The Municipality of Saint Bernard reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
